

# COAST GUARD MOTOR LIFEBOAT 36460



Meet United States Coast Guard Motor Lifeboat 36460. This 36-foot Motor Lifeboat was built in 1941 in Curtis Bay, Maryland and represents one of the most widely used and relied upon rescue boats in Coast Guard history. These self-bailing and self-righting workhorses could handle icy conditions and waves up to 60 feet, had a watertight survivors' cabin and engine rooms and 2000lb bronze keels. 36460 served for 35 years before retiring and underwent several restorations by new owners. 36460 starred in the Disney film *The Finest Hours*, which tells the true story of the 1952 Pendleton oil tanker rescue. After its time in the spotlight in Hollywood, 36460 has found a home in the MMM fleet!
