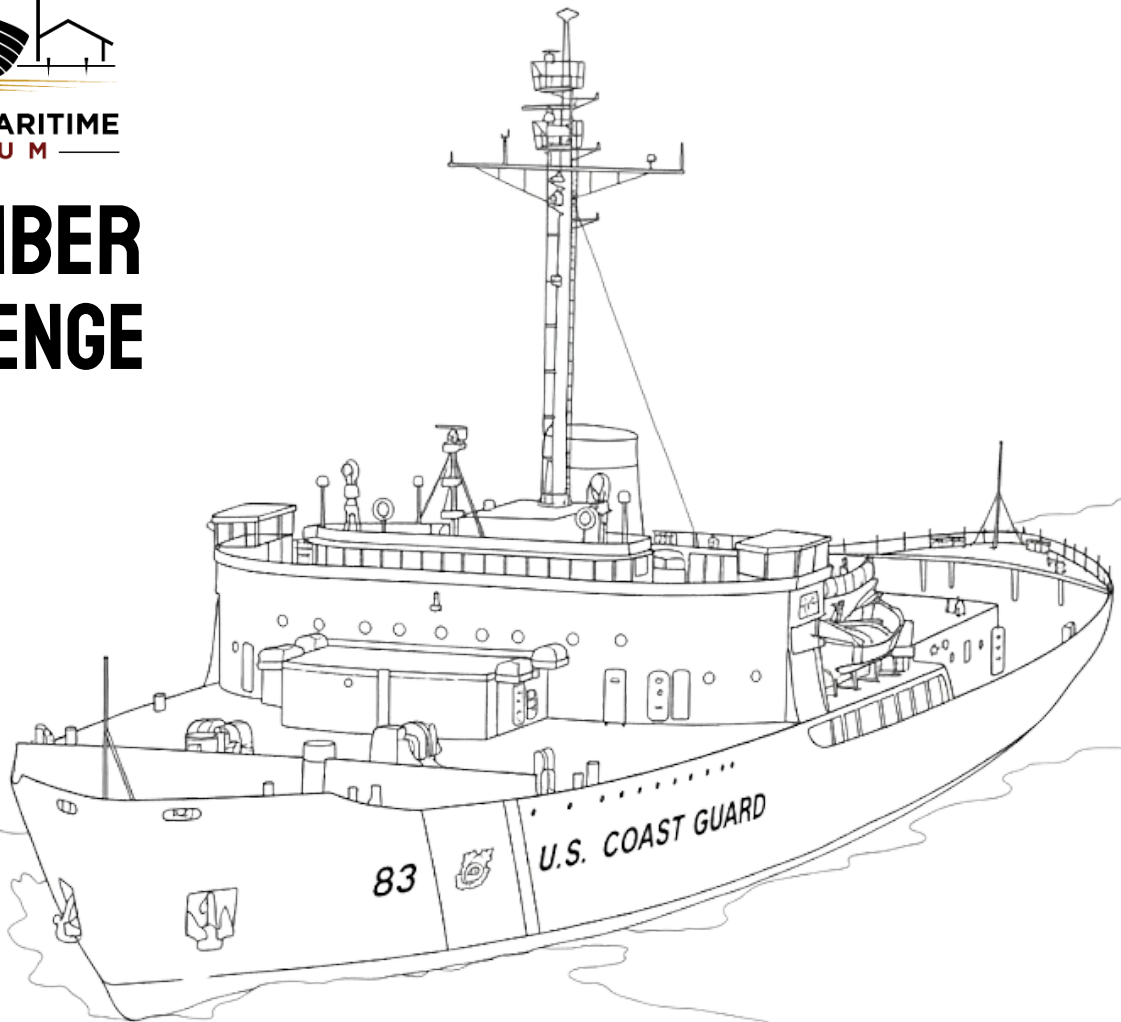




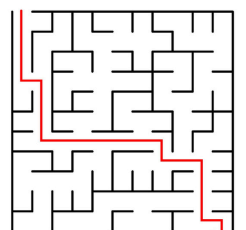
DECEMBER CHALLENGE



U.S. COAST GUARD ICEBREAKER

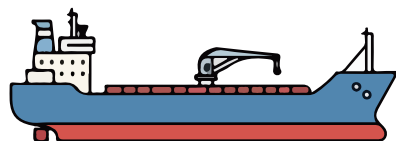

During the winter, the Great Lakes can be covered in ice. Ice breakers such as the U.S. Coast Guard's ship, Mackinaw, were designed to clear a pathway through the ice for other ships to navigate. The Mackinaw was capable of breaking through up to two and a half feet of ice continuously or up to 11 feet thick of ice by ramming! One of the most famous ships on the Great Lakes, it was finally decommissioned in 2006 and it was replaced by the icebreaker Mackinaw II which serves on the Great Lakes today.

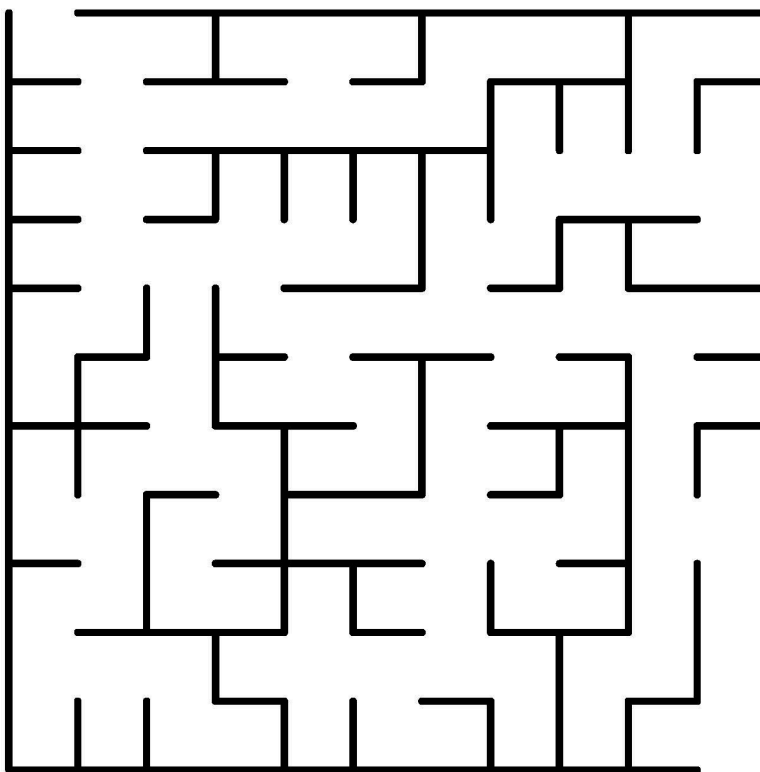


Answer:
