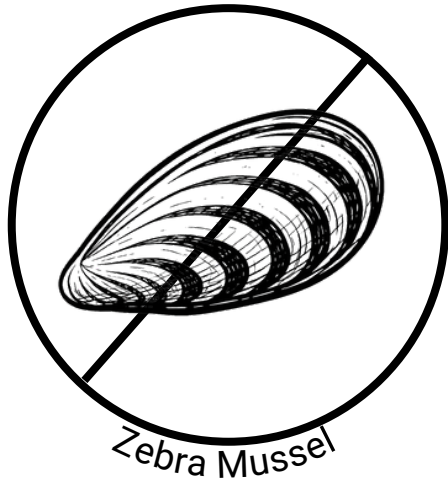


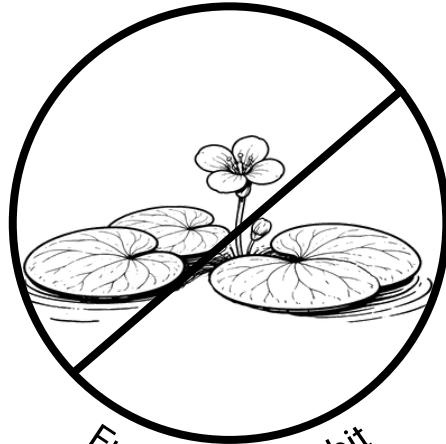

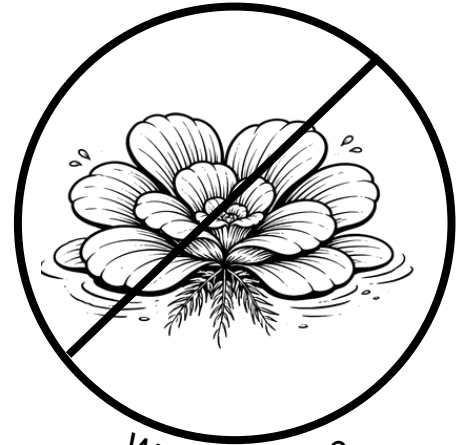

STOP AQUATIC INVASIVE SPECIES
CLEAN, DRAIN & DRY YOUR BOATS!

WE ALL HAVE A ROLE IN LIMITING THE IMPACT OF INVASIVE SPECIES. HELP SPREAD THE WORD.

Invasive species are non-native plants and animals that threaten native habitats. Since the 1800s, more than 180 aquatic species have entered the Great Lakes. Today, 42% of endangered native species are at risk due to their impact, costing the region an estimated \$200 million annually.

There are important steps we can all take to prevent the introduction and spread of aquatic invasive species. When boating, remember to clean your boat and trailer, drain all water, and dry your boat and equipment.

It's not just good practice—it's the law.
